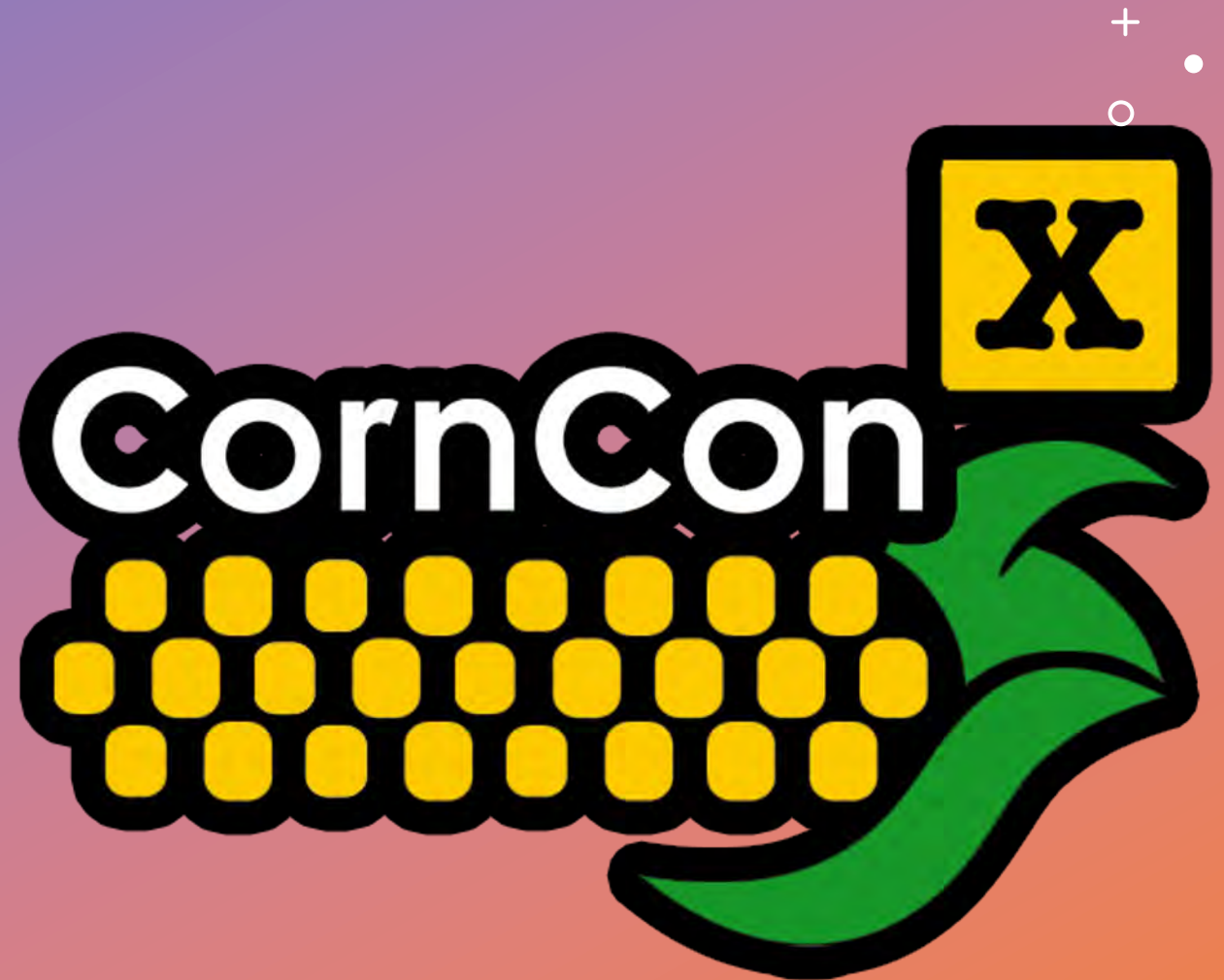

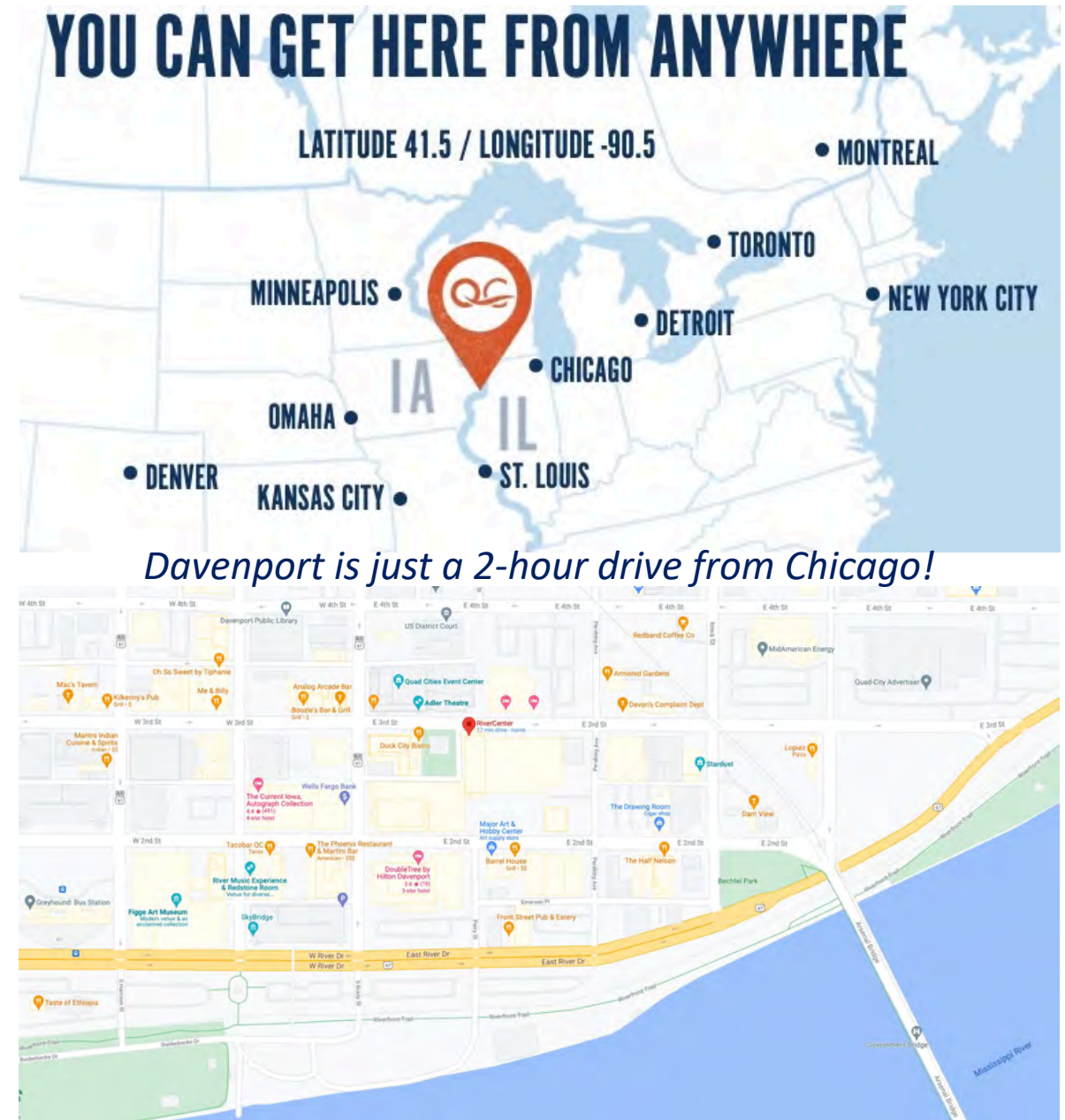
- **Expected turn-out in 2024 is 400 - 500 people**

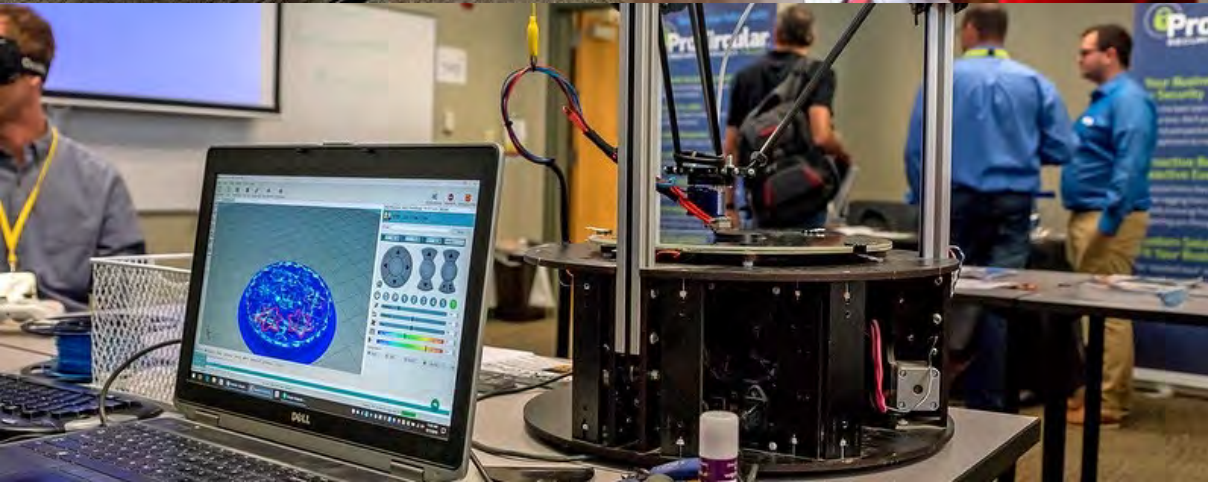
